SUBJECT: FLUSH ADVISORY

Dear Water Customer,

In the early morning hours of June 8, 2009, you may have experienced a low pressure condition. This was caused by a mechanical failure at the well site after fighting two house fires this past weekend.

The low water condition in the tower caused us to do a rapid fill on the tower. When this happens, there is a possibility that sediment can be stirred up in the lines. You may experience cloudy water for a couple of days. The water is safe for human consumption.

We may have no choice but to do a flushing after this event. If that becomes necessary, we will post flushing signs at the entrance of your subdivision and/or in the area. Please avoid washing clothes while flushing is being conducted in your area.

The mechanical problem has been resolved at this time. We apologize for any inconvenience that this may have caused.
